Next Meeting 4th February 2 to 4pm 'Making Name Badges' Led by Terry Pearce.

Now that BEG has gained new members, there have been requests asking everyone to wear a name badge so that everyone knows who they are stitching with!



Terry will bring:

Cards measuring three and a quarter by four inches

Samples

6" square ruler

Ribbons

Wadding cut to size

Names for each member - if you would prefer to do your own name it needs to measure two and a half inches long by $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide

There will also be pin clasps available if required.

Members to bring:

Fabric - calico or light colour measuring 6" square

Contrasting dark fabric for back and sides

Marker Pen

Pins or clips

6" square ruler

Thread or Perle cotton for embroidery

Matching ribbon or cord 30" long x $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide

5" embroidery hoop
