Esther's course will be based on Embroidered Leaves and Flowers, very similar to the planned Lara Sparks course but using a slightly different technique and fabric. The cost will be £35.00 and if it is ok with you, rather than offering a £5.00 refund we will put it towards the next afternoon meeting attended. We will offer a refund if you prefer and if you no longer wish to join us on the 20th at 10am April. We will need your bank details.

Esther and Jill thought the best option for the workshop was Embroidered leaves and flowers, (this was the most popular one that members chose on Saturday)

The course details are:-

Machine Embroidered leaves and flowers is suitable for those with some experience of machine embroidery. Learn how to make a variety of beautiful machine embroidered fabric flowers and leaves, suitable for all sorts of embellishments and accessories. Then enjoy adding beads or sequins to complete your pieces. We will be using organza and net along with dissolvable fabric to create some stunning effects. There is no extra charge for the materials/fabric.



You will need to bring along your own sewing machine with embroidery/darning foot and a selection of threads. Plus, an embroidery hoop and sharp embroidery/small scissors.

We do have some sewing machines, hoops and scissors you could borrow but please let me know.

I can imagine the flowers and leaves used to embellish bags, fascinators, brooches, blouses or other items.

If you didn't plan to join Lara Sparks workshop, but would like to attend the Esther Collins workshop, there are more places available, as she will take up to 15 students.
